


everything, certainly not everything at the church. When thinking about them, pick and choose those events that quicken your spirit and lift your countenance.




## **Edwin Eberman**

Our featured artist this Advent season is the late Edwin Eberman, a long time member of this church. He was known to New Canaanites as a local artist and one whose influence can be felt throughout our town and our church, painting and drawing many New Canaan landmarks. He designed the Memorial Garden and the cross there is the original one, dating from 1978.

Ed, as he was known, was born in 1905 and died in 1986. After graduating from Carnegie Melon he went to New York where he was art director at a number of magazines. He and his wife, Janet, moved to New Canaan in 1941 and became members of the church that year. He was one of the founders of the Famous Artists Schools in Westport, CT and upon retirement he enjoyed some 20 years of creativity in his studio and in his gardens. Many scenes of his travels were recorded in his annual Christmas card booklet. His pen and ink of the church was used for many decades on the weekly program.



Through all the years, Mr. Eberman nurtured and developed what became an abiding, lifelong passion for art. In fact, his daughter, New Canaan resident Alice Dalrymple, recalled recently he was known to say that he could not remember a time when he was not "always drawing." It's one of many ways that Mr. Eberman's talent took form in New Canaan, along with more permanent examples such as Christmas cards, sketches of local scenes, paintings, and pieces still in place at the New Canaan Inn, Waveny Care Center and in our church.







Looking ahead to December, MSYG will have the opportunity to ring bells and raise money for the Salvation Army on Sunday, December 4.


# Youth Christmas Worship


