

FROM THE PASTOR'S STUDY

Dear Church Family,

I so love the seasons of Advent and Christmas on God's Acre. For me, it isn't just about the Norman Rockwell-like experience on our hill as people near and far gather to sing Christmas carols with the Town Band around our illuminated tree. It is the transition from Thanksgiving to Advent when Anthony Jones, Juliet Howe, and the other members of the Flower Ministry Team come together to adorn our meeting house and church property with wreaths, lights, and crèche scenes. I don't think there is a place more beautiful in the world than our Meeting House on a Sunday morning in Advent or during worship on Christmas Eve when we gather together amid all the seasonal adornments. I know that our God inhabits far more than an acre infinite time and space, but it is hard not to sense the presence of the Divine on our little patch of New Canaan real estate this time of year.

Advent and Christmas are a wonderful reminder of what a gift it is to serve as your pastor in this place and time. I continue to give thanks to God for you all and for our shared life together!


One of the particular gifts of this season that we will be sharing with you is somewhat unexpected — delightfully so. As I mentioned in a message over the summer, Tammie and I had the opportunity to visit with a Naples, NY artist whose work we had admired for years. Darryl Abraham has a very distinct style, and he is known for his wonderful and whimsical Finger Lakes vineyard landscapes and artistic depictions of local insti-



tutions and landmarks. One day, while browsing his website, I noticed that he had a tab dedicated to Holy Land art, which seemed like an unusual departure from the work for which he is known. I contacted Darryl and arranged for Tammie and me to visit his studio to see some of his Middle Eastern collection.

When we arrived, Darryl had hung his entire gallery with much of his Holy Land art just for our viewing pleasure. We learned that he is a deeply committed person of faith and had spent all but four years of his life in the town of Naples. Those four years away from his hometown were spent in Israel, where his wife undertook a teaching sojourn.



During those years, Darryl captured scene after scene of the people and places he frequented, from Israel to the West Bank to the country of Jordan. He mentioned that he loved the work he was able to engage in during those years, but in Naples, people didn't have much interest in his Holy Land pieces. He was delighted by our interest, and through his generosity, we have been able to acquire most of his collection for our church. Much of the online images and artwork you have seen in our various publications are his work. We have also commissioned Darryl to create a few additional pieces to fulfill our liturgical needs. Darryl has even produced his own variation of our beloved Christmas Eve caroling tradition.

It is our hope that a tableau of his work will be formally displayed (graciously presented by our own Nathalie Schubert) in our Narthex on the First Sunday of Advent, or shortly thereafter. In a season of gift-giving and receiving, it is wonderful to have and share Darryl's work as a community.

I trust that you share my fondness for our New Canaan faith home, particularly at this time of year. I hope you and those you love will make your way to our church for one of our many Advent and Christmas programs or services. And when you have a moment, please pass through the Narthex that leads into our Meeting House and admire the gift of Holy Land images that have been generously produced and shared with our church by a very gifted artist, a fine human being, and an insightful person of faith: Darryl Abraham.


